



Upcoming Bridge Replacement Project
Lancaster County

The Pennsylvania Department of Transportation's (PennDOT) Rapid Bridge Replacement Projects will begin soon in Lancaster County. A total of 31 Lancaster County bridges are due for replacement, with 11 starting this year, 19 in 2017 and one in 2018.

The project contractor, Plenary Walsh Keystone Partners (PWKP) invites the public to view a plans display for the following project starting construction in 2017:

BRIDGE: **Harmony Ridge Road (SR 3004) over Fishing Creek (JV281)**

LOCATION: **Drumore Township Building, 1675 Furniss Road, Drumore PA 17518**

During construction, scheduled for summer 2017, traffic would be detoured about six and a half miles.
