AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE OFFICIAL DRUMORE TOWNSHIP **ORDINANCE** NO. 2010-02 **ENTITLED** ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH REGULATIONS CONCERNING INSTALLATION, INSPECTION, AND **ONGOING** MAINTENANCE OF ALL ON-LOT SEWAGE DISPOSAL SYSTEMS; TO REQUIRE THE REGISTRATION OF SEPTAGE **PUMPER/HAULERS**; TO PERMIT INTERVENTION SITUATIONS WHICH MAY CONSTITUTE A PUBLIC NUISANCE OR HAZARD TO THE PUBLIC HEALTH; TO ESTABLISH PROCEDURES, PENALTIES AND APPEAL RIGHTS NECESSARY FOR THE PROPER ADMINISTRATION OF **SEWAGE** \mathbf{A} MANAGEMENT PROGRAM FOR THE TOWNSHIP OF DRUMORE.

WHEREAS, the Township of Drumore wishes to amend their Ordinance No. 2010-02 establishing certain standards and regulations for on-lot disposal systems within the Township; and

BE IT HEREBY ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of Drumore Township, Lancaster County, Pennsylvania, that Ordinance No. 2010-02 shall be amended in the following respects:

<u>Section 1</u>. Section 11.E. of the Ordinance (regarding the voluntary pump-out of tanks prior to the date required by the Ordinance) shall be rescinded in its entirety and amended to provide, in full, as follows:

E. Owners may choose to have their system inspected and tanks pumped out more frequently than required by this Section of the Ordinance. In the event of a more frequent inspection and pumping performed by an Authorized Agent, and the receipt by Drumore Township of the report and certification by such Authorized Agent as specified in Section 11.D. above, the date of the subsequent required regular inspection and pump out shall be deemed to be the last day of the month three years after such voluntary inspection and pump out. The ultimate responsibility for insuring that Drumore Township has received a copy of such written report shall be upon Owner.
