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ORDINANCE NO. 2021-01

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AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE ADOPTION OF RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR ALL DRUMORE TOWNSHIP PARKS, ESTABLISHING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS OF THE RULES AND REGULATIONS, AND AUTHORIZING THE POSTING OF THE RULES AND REGULATIONS IN DRUMORE TOWNSHIP PARKS

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors has determined that rules and regulations should be adopted pertaining to use of the Drumore Township Parks; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors has determined that such Rules and Regulations are necessary for and in furtherance of the health, safety and welfare of the Township, its residents, and all persons lawfully using the Parks located in Drumore Township; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors has further determined that the authority should be granted for the imposition of penalties and fines imposed for the violation of the rules and regulations; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Drumore, Lancaster County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

Section 1. The following Rules and Regulations are adopted and will be applicable in all Drumore Township Parks:

1. Hours of Operation – Dawn to Dusk.
2. No alcoholic beverages, no fires and no camping
3. No person shall use profane language or conduct themselves in any lewd, immoral, or commonly objectionable manner in any park.
4. All dogs and other pets must be leashed and/or under full control.
5. No parking on athletics fields.
6. All persons requesting use of any park facilities and/or fields must contact Drumore Township and complete a request form.
7. Pick up all debris and litter.
8. The maximum occupancy for each park pavilion is 50 adults.

Section 2. The Rules and Regulations adopted herein shall be prominently displayed in each of the Drumore Township Parks.

Section 3. Violations of the Rules and Regulations enacted herein may result in the imposition of fines and/or penalties on any person(s) not acting in compliance with the same.

Section 4. The Board of Supervisors reserves the right to modify, supplement or amend the Rules and Regulations from time to time by resolution or ordinance.

Section 5. The provisions of this Ordinance are severable and if any section, sentence, clause, part or provision hereof shall be held illegal, invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision of the court shall not affect the remaining sections, sentences, clauses, parts or provisions of this Ordinance. It is hereby declared to be the intent of the Board of Supervisors that this Ordinance would have been enacted if such illegal, invalid or unconstitutional section, sentence, clause, part or provision had not been included herein.


Section 6. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its enactment by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Drumore as provided by law.

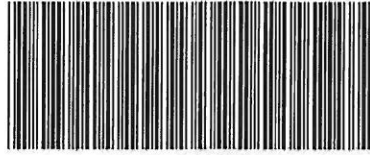
