ORDINANCE NO. 2010-02

AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH REGULATIONS CONCERNING THE INSTALLATION, INSPECTION, AND ONGOING MAINTENANCE OF ALL ON-LOT SEWAGE DISPOSAL SYSTEMS; TO REQUIRE THE REGISTRATION OF SEPTAGE PUMPER/HAULERS; TO PERMIT INTERVENTION IN SITUATIONS WHICH MAY CONSTITUTE A PUBLIC NUISANCE OR HAZARD TO THE PUBLIC HEALTH; TO ESTABLISH PROCEDURES, PENALTIES AND APPEAL RIGHTS NECESSARY FOR THE PROPER ADMINISTRATION OF A SEWAGE MANAGEMENT PROGRAM FOR THE TOWNSHIP OF DRUMORE.

BE AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Board of Supervisors of the Drumore Township, Lancaster County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>. <u>Title</u>. This Ordinance shall be known and may be cited as the "Drumore Township On-Lot Sewage Disposal System Management Ordinance."

Section 2. Definitions and Word Usage.

A. Word Usage. In the interpretation of this Ordinance, the singular shall include the plural, and the masculine shall include the feminine and the neuter.

B. Definitions.

Absorption Area Easement - A portion of a lot, tract, or parcel that encompasses the primary and replacement absorption area and which shall be delineated and preserved. The primary and replacement absorption areas need not be contiguous.

Act - The Pennsylvania Sewage Facilities Act, Act of January 24, 1966, P.L. (1965) 1535, No. 537, as amended, 35 P.S. Section 750.1 et al. seq.

Authorized Agent - A Certified Sewage Enforcement Officer (SEO) or a licensed pumper/hauler for the Township.

Board - The Board of Supervisors for Drumore Township, Lancaster County, Pennsylvania.
